Urology Department

Range of urology services

Kidney

- Robot-assisted (with the da Vinci®system) and laparoscopic partial kidney resection
- Laparoscopic nephrectomy (kidney removal)
- Open surgical partial kidney resection and nephrectomy
- Radiofrequency ablation
- Treatment of advanced and metastasised renal cell carcinoma

Bladder

- TUR-B (transurethral resection of bladder tumours, including fluorescence-based)
- Radical cystectomy (bladder removal) with creation of an ileal conduit, ileal neobladder or Mansoura pouch (open and robot-assisted)
- Partial bladder resection (open and robot-assisted)
- Chemotherapy

Prostate

- Nerve-sparing prostate vesiculectomy (open surgical and robot-assisted with the da Vinci®system)
- Laparoscopic lymphadenectomy
- MRI ultrasound fusion biopsy of the prostate

Penis and testicles

- Partial penectomy, poss. penectomy
- Inguinal and pelvic lymphadenectomy
- Ablatio testis
- Retroperitoneal lymphadenectomy (open surgical and minimally invasive)
- Chemo and radiotherapy for penile and testicular tumours

Robot-assisted operations with the da Vinci®system

- Radical prostatectomy, pyeloplasty, partial kidney resection, ureteral neoimplantation, cystectomy, ureteral replacement

Urological stone therapy

- ESWL
- Rigid and flexible URS (ureteroscopy) with laser lithotripsy
- PNL / mini-PNL (percutaneous nephrolitholapaxy)

Treatment of bladder voiding disorders

- TUR-P (transurethral resection of the prostate)
- Holmium laser enucleation of the prostate (HoLEP)
- Urethrotomia interna (urethrotomian slit)
- Botulinum toxin injection for overactive bladder
- Bladder augmentation for contracted bladder

Therapies for male genital diseases

- Circumcision
- Hydrocelectomy
- Schröder-Essed operation for penile curvature

Reconstructive urology

- Laparoscopic pyeloplasty (pyeloplasty), laser endopyelotomy
- Implantation of a penile prosthesis (AMS 700) for erectile disorders
- Implantation of an artificial sphincter (AMS 800 or Zephyr), advance band for urinary incontinence
- Urethroplasty with oral mucosa
